The Minor Injury and Illness Clinic provides **free walk-in urgent care** for non-life threatening injuries and illnesses.

The clinic is run by a team of doctors, nurses and allied health professionals experienced in treating urgent medical needs. They can assess, diagnose, and treat a wide range of minor injuries and illnesses in adults, young children, teenagers, young adults, and babies.



The Minor Injury and Illness Clinic can help if you have:

- minor head injuries with no loss of consciousness
- minor burns
- sprains and strains
- suspected broken bones
- eye conditions such as conjunctivitis or scratches
- foreign bodies in the eyes, ears or nose
- bites and stings
- skin, ear, throat and chest infections
- minor allergic reactions
- urinary tract infections.

The Minor Injury and Illness Clinic is not an emergency department. The safest and fastest way to access help in an emergency is to call **000**.
